



# VISA FIFA CUSCAL PROMOTION

## Terms and Conditions

### HOW TO ENTER

To be automatically entered into the draw, individuals must spend a minimum of \$20 in a single transaction on their Visa Debit card (by using the 'credit' function) between 05/02/10 and 5:30pm AEST on 25/04/10.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. Entry is only open to Australian residents aged 16 years or over who have a valid passport as at 09/05/10, which will have at least six months validity remaining from 21/06/10.
3. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter and agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.

Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
5. Entrants will receive one (1) entry into the draw for each time \$20 is spent on their Visa Debit card (by using the 'credit' function) in a single transaction. Limit one (1) entry per eligible transaction, regardless of the amount spent in that transaction.
6. If there is a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the entrant.
7. The promotion commences on 05/02/10 and ends at 5:30pm AEST on 25/04/10. The draw will take place at Anisimoff Legal, Level 4, 448 St Kilda Road, Melbourne VIC 3004 on 28/04/10 at 2pm.
8. The winner will be notified by phone and by mail and the winner's name will be published in The Australian on 30/04/10. The first drawn winner must claim the prize by 2pm AEST on 04/05/10 otherwise the prize will be forfeited and another winner will be drawn in the unclaimed prize draw.
9. The Promoter's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
